Pursuant to the implementation of the **Short-Term Mobility and Skills Enhancement Program Abroad** for the 2026 fiscal year, all academic staff and non-permanent doctoral candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria established under **Decision No. 255 dated 25 February 2024**, which defines the selection and admission standards for the program (as specified in the evaluation matrices appended to the decision) are hereby invited to submit their applications within the period **20 January to 5 February 2026, by 23:59**.

Applicants are required to compile a complete dossier containing the documents listed below and to submit it **via the designated digital platform** accessible at the following link:

I. Skills Enhancement Training Abroad (for Assistant Professors and Non-Permanent Doctoral Candidates)

Applicants are required to submit a complete dossier containing the following documents:

- A **formal written request** specifying the host country and institution, as well as the proposed duration of the training;
- The **latest employment or promotion decision**;
- The **appointment decision**;
- **Doctoral enrollment certificates** (regular enrollment starting from the second registration), indicating the number of registrations in accordance with the applicable regulations;
- **Non-affiliation certificates** (CNAS/CASNOS) for non-permanent doctoral candidates;
- A **comprehensive and detailed work plan** that addresses the scientific and objective requirements outlined in the attached decision, specifying the objectives, methodology, and expected outcomes;
- All **documents substantiating academic, pedagogical, and administrative responsibilities** (certificates or employment decisions only) included in the evaluation framework, completed during the current fiscal year corresponding to the last benefit or from the date of appointment, or within the preceding three years, depending on the applicant's status, up to **25 January 2026**.

II. Short-Term High-Level Scientific Residency (for Professors, Senior Lecturers “A” and Lecturers “B”)

Applicants are required to submit a complete dossier containing the following documents:

- A **formal written request** specifying the host country and institution, as well as the proposed duration of the residency;
- The **latest employment or promotion decision**;
- The **appointment decision**;
- A **comprehensive and detailed work plan** that fulfills the scientific and objective requirements outlined in the attached decision, specifying objectives, methodology, and expected outcomes;
- All **documents evidencing academic, pedagogical, and administrative responsibilities** (certificates or employment decisions only) included in the evaluation framework, completed during the current fiscal year corresponding to the last benefit or from the date of appointment, or within the preceding three years, depending on the applicant's status, up to **25 January 2026**.

Please note :

- Short-term mobility abroad in the bibliographic category is **restricted to documentary centers and specialized databases**;
- **Incomplete application files** (missing administrative documents) or **documents submitted after the deadline** will not be accepted;
- Applications of candidates who **have not utilized their previous years' grants** will not be considered;
- **Educational documents previously used** in the university qualification dossier **will not be counted**.
